2 EASY Ways to Get Trained Conveniently

Are you prepared and trained for a natural disaster? Here are 2 EASY ways to get trained conveniently. Take a look at the following options available to you:

1. Draper CERT Training Class Registration

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations.

Draper city is hosting a new hybrid-style CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) program in October. Students will have 12 hours of interactive online training that can be completed at your convenience. We are allotting a total of six weeks for students to complete the online course. The classroom portion will be taught on two separate eight-hour days consisting of skills only. For any questions regarding CERT contact Captain Steve Darlington (Program Coordinator) or Erin Lytle (Course Coordinator).

Take the [online class](#) between August 16 and September 30, 2021. All class materials are accessible at the online class site. The hands-on practical skills portion will be October 2 and 9 from 8 AM to 5 PM at Fire Station 22 (14324 Fire House Rd, Draper). [Pre-registration](#) is required for the hands-on classes.
