April: Home Flood Prevention

Got Snow???

Here is some helpful information to prevent home flooding:

Home Inspections:

- 1. Inspect every room and window in your basement each day is there water?
 - a. If so, find the source (cracks in foundation, gaps in window frame)
- 2. Inspect rain gutters and down spouts
 - a. Clean out debris
 - b. Make sure the discharge is away from your home
 - c. Remove all ice dams
- 3. Inspect your sump pump and make sure it is working
 - a. Clean out all drainage lines
 - b. Make sure the discharge is away from your home
- 4. Inspect the outside of your home is there any standing water or water draining towards your home?

Additional Information:

- Sand Bag Placement: Place the sandbags OUTSIDE and against the doors or window wells where water may enter your home. Garage: If water comes into your garage, sandbags should be directly against the access door.
- 2. <u>Ice Damning:</u> An ice dam is a ridge of ice that forms at the edge of a roof and prevents melting snow (water) from draining off the roof. The water that backs up behind the dam can leak into a home and cause damage to walls, ceilings, insulation and other areas. Remove snow from the roof. This eliminates one of the ingredients necessary for the formation of an ice dam.
