March: Communications

What is your Family Communications Plan? Have you reached out to your Neighbors and involved them?

The first communications infrastructures to buckle under the weight of traffic in an emergency are cell phone towers. Thus, the importance of well thought out, coordinated emergency communications cannot be overly stressed with our family and neighbors.

Family Radio Service (FRS): These walkie talkies are part of the Suncrest District's backup emergency communications plan. An FCC license is not required to use these radios. They have a limited range and less power than GMRS radios, which require an FCC license (\$70 for the family; no test; lasts 10 years). HAM radios require passing an exam that costs around \$15. They can be significantly higher in cost but can communicate where there are geographic barriers (mountains). FRS and GMRS radios are line-of-sight communicators.
