Aug: Earthquake Prep

The best time to prepare for any disaster is before it happens – especially an Earthquake in Salt Lake City Utah.

Here are some simple tips and information to help you be better prepared for an Earthquake.

1. Practice Drop, Cover, and Hold On with your family







- 2. Make an Emergency Plan: Create a <u>family emergency communications plan</u> that has an out-of-state contact. Plan where to meet if you get separated. <u>Make a supply kit</u> that includes enough food and water for several days, a flashlight, a fire extinguisher and a whistle. Include non-perishable foods, cleaning supplies, and water for several days, in case services are cut off in your area. If you are able to, set aside items like soap, hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol, disinfecting wipes, and general household cleaning supplies that you can use to disinfect surfaces you touch regularly. After an earthquake, you may not have access to these supplies for days or even weeks.
- 3. Protect Your Home: Secure heavy items in your home like bookcases, refrigerators, water heater, televisions and objects that hang on walls. Store heavy and breakable objects on low shelves. Consider making improvements to your building to fix structural issues that could cause your building to collapse during an earthquake. Consider obtaining an earthquake insurance policy. A standard homeowner's insurance policy does not cover earthquake damage.
