Goals:

- Work with members of the ward to assist with Family History Account login and how to make appointments for temple service.
- Utilize the ward Temple and Family History Committee to visit with members in their homes. Visit with 1-2 families (individuals) per week. Help them learn about their ancestors, discover their stories, and perform temple ordinances on their behalf.
- Encourage members to utilize one of the FamilySearch Centers in our area. Our Stake is currently assigned to the Riverton Family Search Center.
- Promote a monthly ward temple activity. Reservations are made on the third Friday of every month at 7:00 p.m. for Temple Sealings. Youth will participate in Temple Baptisms on a quarterly basis.
- Adults and youth will be taught in Relief Society, Priesthood, and YW classes about the new “Get Involved” app on their phones. Regular utilization will be encouraged.
- Elders Quorum and Relief Society Presidencies will provide a monthly Temple and Family History opportunity. Ward Temple and Family History Consultants will be utilized.
