

2025 Suncrest 2nd Ward Mission Plan

INTENT: Keep missionary work simple – Being genuine friends through LOVING, SHARING & INVITING!

GOAL: Every ward member will expand his or her circle of friends by reaching out to neighbors, other ward members and those to whom they minister. As a ward, we will work together to reach a goal of **at least four (4) 2025 convert baptisms.**

HOW: By seeking the Lord's help and guidance, we will be natural, genuine, bold and kind in our interactions with ward members, friends and neighbors. Some ideas include:

- Have a member attend every lesson (at least after the first lesson) with the missionaries...and, ideally, hold the lesson at members' homes (rotating members).
- Pray daily for opportunities to serve and share.
 - Pray specifically for individuals and guidance.
- No one sits alone.
 - Whether at church, church activities, or a community event, always look to sit with someone who is sitting alone or is new.
- Get to know someone new each week.
- Do something for or with a neighbor of another faith (or less active ward member) at least once a month – take a treat, invite over for a BBQ, etc.
- Reach out to someone who wasn't at church to let them know they were missed.
- Thank and Compliment youth (and others) for their service and a job well done in teaching, speaking, etc.
- Help organize and take part in a block party with your neighbors a couple of times a year.
- Look for opportunities to service a neighbor, or to invite a neighbor to join you in serving.

OUTCOME: We will become closer and stronger as a ward by getting to know and becoming friends with many more of our neighbors. This will bring natural opportunities to answer questions and share our own beliefs and testimonies with those who are interested, as we Invite them to: Come & See, Come & Serve, and Come & Stay. With those not interested, at least we will establish true & lasting friendships.
